


## Bur Story

I work as a computer nerd in Marketing for a bank and spend my free time crafting, DIYing, reading, singing, biking, or spending quality time with my girlfriends.


Church and music are very important to me as well. I spend a few weekends every month singing at one of our church campuses. I've been doing this for over 15 years and love it.













### Hi, I'm Andrew




### His Family















